Students receive wrap-around supports Assistant Principal will provide monthly assemblies.

Instructional staff participate in PLC's Analyze data related to outreach efforts for students not present in school.

Accountability Measure:

Overall improvement of school climate and culture.

Teaching and learning environment becomes optimal for all stakeholders.

Educational Goal #3 – High School Completions

How We Measure:

Accountability Measure:

Through teacher observation and daily monitoring of student outcomes
Assistant Principal will conduct weekly walk through and observations
Professional development with instructional staff on academic and classroom management implementation
Monthly PLC's for instructional staff
APEX Learning formative assessments, PSAT, SAT and ACT will be positively impacted.

Daily monitoring, weekly observations and the implementation of Blended Learning. Individualized intentional academic supports to meet assessed needs.

Professional development for instructional staff will assist in aligning supports and resources to meet the needs of students.

Educational Goal #4 - Achievement

- SYLA will report average M-STEP results in English Language Arts and Math to DPSCD yearly
- 50% of all SYLA students will complete 2 courses per semester in APEX Learning

How We Measure:

SYLA Instructional Team and Counselor will monitor course completions in APEX Learning and provide supports based on student need SYLA Data Team will analyze M-STEP results in ELA and Math

SYLA will provide a report to DPSCD on M-STEP results for ELA and Math SYLA Leadership Team will schedule academic interventions to address learning gaps

MTSS will provide additional support Monthly PLC's based on literacy and numeracy

APEX formative assessments, PSAT, SAT scores are positively impacted

Accountability Measure:

Intentional school-wide data analysis, monthly PLC's, and targeted academic interventions will increase course completions and other academic outcomes.

Educational Goal #5 – Career and College Readiness

At least 50% of the SYLA graduating seniors that attain a diploma will complete application to community colleges and/or universities and FAFSA.

- 100% of SYLA will work in the XELLO platform.
- SYLA students with at least 11th grade status will visit with a 2-4 year college tour
- Students will be exposed to Military branches and PCT opportunities.

How We Measure:

SYLA Counselor will schedule meetings with students to develop goals for completing

Accountability Measure:

graduation requirements to ensure preparedness for career and college readiness.

Counselor in conjunction with ISY Case Manager assists seniors with completion of FAFSA, scholarships, community college and university applications

Students attend career fairs and college tours to community colleges and universities

SYLA will provide support to encourage graduating seniors to be career and college ready upon graduation.

Seniors will be well informed of various opportunities and able to make informed decisions regarding their future
